An artist sees possibilities of a masterpiece where a skeptic sees imperfections.

Colours, a few strokes and an imagination running wild- all that you need to be painter. Canvas? Face? Paper? Leaf? Wood? There is nothing that can't be made into a piece of art if you have the heart for it.

Come join us for ***Rang Lekhan*** -the Painting Competition at the first ever Cultural Fest of National Law University-Assam “**Aduj**” this year and paint the city red.

Rules:

1. The Competition is open to **all students** pursuing any degree from any College/ University. There shall be no bar on number of participants from a College/University.
2. The medium for the Competition is **Acrylic on Canvas**.
3. The composition should be **abstract** reflecting the ‘**Cultural Beauty of North-East India**’. The participants are free to come up with their own

interpretation of this theme. The judging, however, shall be done on how well they **justify** their composition.

4. The participants are to use only **five colours** for the Competition- one from the family of each of **Red, Blue, Yellow, Black and White**. They may choose their own shades i.e only one from each family. In other words, the participants are allowed to use a total of five colours- only one shade of red, only one shade of blue, only one shade of yellow, only one shade of black and only one shade of white. They are allowed to make a palette by mixing only these five colours. Use of more than these five colours shall lead to disqualification. Judging shall be done on the **creative** use of these limited shades.

5. The time limit shall be **3 hours** which may be extended to 4 hours.

6. The participants shall be provided with the Canvas, water, napkins and disposable plates. They are to bring their own colours and tools. There is no bar on use of any kind of tools (scalpels, spatulas, detail brush, etc.). In no case, shall a second canvas be provided to any participant.

7. All participants are encouraged to produce original and authentic work. Any work infringing the rights in any copyrighted work shall lead to disqualification.

8. The participants are not allowed to take the help of any material, picture, graph, etc. as reference during the Competition.

Registration:

1. The registration fee for the Competition is **Rs. 250/-** per person.

2. The registrations are open online as well as on spot till half an hour before the commencement of the Competition.
3. The registered participants are to be gathered at the Venue half an hour before the commencement of the Competition.
4. The Registration Fee is **non-refundable**.

Prizes:

1. The Cash Prizes:
 - a. 1st Prize: Rs. 5000/-
 - b. 2nd Prize: Rs. 3500/-
 - c. 3rd Prize: Rs. 2500/-
2. Certificates of Achievement as well as Participation.
3. Mementos
4. Chance to **exhibit** your work at a local gallery.
